### Biography for Jessica A. Moore

Jessica Ann Moore, was born on December 11, 1990 in Hopkinsville, KY. Jessica was the cofounder of Drop Out to Degree Program, Inc now known as the Jessica Ann Moore Foundation and an honor student at Seton Hall University majoring in Psychology. Jessica's professional goal was to become a Psychologist specializing in helping men and women in the military who were suffering from Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI).

Jessica also was an aspiring singer. She had recorded two singles and was scheduled to audition at the Apollo Theater in New York on October 3, 2010.

Jessica, a loving, sweet, and caring person that was always willing to help her fellow man performed a heroic act that night. An altercation occurred with a man that was not admitted to the fraternity party. Within minutes, the man returned, kicked in the door, and began firing a gun. Jessica's friend was shot in the face and arm. Jessica in a heroic fashion attempted to shield her friend from further injury was shot in the back of the head as a result. Jessica later died of her injuries on September 25, 2010. A senseless crime took out angel home too soon. This tragedy has affected people both national and international and inspired many to action.

Students in Grade 12 who will be attending college in the fall.

Transcript showing GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

National Test Scores, SAT = 1300, Act = 20, and PSAT 1200. (This includes all test).

Typewritten essay of 500 words. Topic is stated below on page 13.
